Notes

2021 was marked by a smooth growing season with low yields and intensely flavored, small-sized fruit. January and February saw rain but were followed by little rainfall for the rest of the season, which provided an ideal environment for grapes to flower. Budbreak occurred in early April, followed by bloom in May and ripening in the summer. The season saw one of the earliest harvests on record, with white wine grapes picked at the end of July.

The Wine

This year's vintage is medium-bodied with exceptional purity and freshness. Flavors of orange blossoms, lemongrass, and green apple merge on the palate, followed by a long finish that highlights balanced acidity with layers of rich, polished fruit.
